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**Subject: Monthly Summary for the Cabinet Council concerning M/o SDE –reg**

Some of the key achievements/ initiatives by this Ministry during the month of August, 2022 are as under:

1. Under Skill India Mission, MSDE is implementing its flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) for Skill based training of the youth across the country including the Differently abled candidates under Short Term Training (STT) courses and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Further, there is an exclusive Sector Skill Council for Differently abled, namely, Skill Council for PwD (SCPwD) for catering to the needs of the Differently abled candidates and run training in PwD-friendly training centres (TCs). These training centres are structurally designed to cover Braille, computer screen reader for visually impaired; sign language interpreter for speech and hearing impaired, etc.

2. To provide skill training to tribal communities, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) launched the second phase of Grameen Udyami Project on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 in Ranchi in partnership with Seva Bharti and Yuva Vikas Society. The objective is to impart functional skills to India's youth for enhancing livelihood opportunity. The programme was launched by Shri Arjun Munda, Union Minister of Tribal affairs in the presence of Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar, Minister of State (MoS) for Skill Development & Entrepreneurship; and Electronics & IT.

3. To augment skill training in the New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) jurisdiction, 1000 candidates were trained in the month of August under Skill India Mission for completing the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) programme, 650 candidates have been certified under this program. The initiative is funded by NDMC and SANKALP programme, a World Bank project. Union Minister of Education and Skill Development Shri Dharmendra Pradhan along with Shri Vinai Kumar Saxena, LG, Delhi presented certificates to 50 NDMC workers for completing Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) program in Delhi.

4. **VCs, Meetings and important decisions:-**

- The 22nd meeting of the National Skills Qualification Committee (NSQC), under NCVET, was held on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. A total of **84** (20 new and 64 revised) Qualifications were considered for approval for alignment with the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF), of which **70** Qualifications were approved by the Committee.

- The 20th Meeting of the Project Execution Committee (PEC) of SANKALP was held under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (SANKALP) on 17.08.2022. Proposals received from various agencies were examined and referred to the Program Approval Board for further consideration.
5. 150 restructured qualifications for Long Term Training program under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS), having annual learning hours 1,200 hours from 1600 hours were put up in the 22<sup>nd</sup> NSQC meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. This is in line with Unified Credit Framework as well as School Education. All these 150 qualifications have been deemed approved by NCVET.
  6. As part of the partnership between the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) and UN Women, capacity-building programmes of MSDE officials on “Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013” was launched on 26 August, 2022.
  7. To strengthen the service delivery and enhance transparency modifications have been done on NCVTMIS (ITI management Information System). E-books of the 06 ITI trades as per revised trade syllabus uploaded on Bharatskills in Hindi & english.
  8. Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav (AKAM) Har Ghar Tianga Campaign:
    - Under Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav (AKAM), 200+ Jan Shikshan Sansthan under MSDE across the country organized programmes to promote Har Ghar Tiranaga Campaign from August 13-15, 2022 in their operational areas.
    - JSSs under MSDE organized an Exhibition on “Partition Horror’s Remembrance Day” under AKAM on 14.08.2022. Through this collective effort, JSSs remembered the sad memories of partition and paid tribute to all those who lost their lives during partition.
    - As part of AKAM Campaign, 14 RPL camps (30 batches) across 14 Adarsh Grams were conducted during August, 2022 wherein 980 candidates were trained.
  9. In addition to the above initiatives, the on-going process for rationalization of work performance through a number of internal measures continued to ensure utmost promptness and efficiency in speedy disposal of all deliverables.

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
