First meeting of Hindi Advisory Committee of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship

The first meeting of the Hindi Advisory Committee of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship was held on 01.08.2023 at 6 pm in Committee Room-C of the Parliament House Annexe under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of the Ministry Shri Dharmendra Pradhan. The Minister of State for the Ministry, Shri Rajeev Chandra Shekhar was also present on this occasion. The nominated members by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs Honorable MPs Mr. Ramesh Bidhuri, Mr. Aditya Prasad and Mr. Sikander Kumar also participated in the meeting. Various suggestions were given by the Hon'ble MPs and non-official members present in the meeting regarding increasing the work in Hindi in the Ministry.

In his address, Hon'ble Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan assured to implement the suggestions given by the members. The Hon'ble Minister further said that the Prime Minister speaks Hindi everywhere in the country and abroad. Hindi language is the most spoken language in India. The Government of India is committed to the development and prosperity of Hindi. Today our youth will have to lay emphasis on learning language and technology along with skills. He also said on this occasion that the Hon'ble Prime Minister has recently launched 100 books on skill development in 12 languages for 23 trades.
